# YOUR FINANCIAL ASSIS- TANCE IS NEEDED

*Dear brother and sister Cursillistas,*

*During the past year, the secretariat and I have been working to find ways to make Cursillo of Cincinnati financially secure. Over the last three years we have been operating at a deficit and have only been able to meet our financial obligations because of timely donations.*

*The Cursillo movement in Cincinnati is faithful to the purpose and mentality of the larger Cursillo movement. The Cursillo movement should be and is an instrument of Christian renewal within our Catholic Church. Pope Francis has been reminding us that the renewal of our personal relationship with God is not obsolete, nor should be forgotten. Since 1962, there have been approximately 16,000 Cursillistas who have made a weekend in Cincinnati. If 10% of the Cursillistas in our area would pledge to give \$10 per year for five years, the Secretariat would be able to meet our financial obligations, and have the ability to provide necessary resources such as books, Cursillo website, newsletter and workshops.*

*If the idea of an annual pledge does not appeal to you, a one-time donation of \$25, \$50 \$100 or any amount you care to donate would be a blessing. Our movement is in critical need of whatever financial support you feel moved to contribute. We have been operating at a deficit (or very close to it), and it is only because of the generous donations we have received, that we are able to continue.*

# Bulletin Board

## Pre-Cursillo:

### There is a lot going on.

There seems to be more enthusiasm, vitality and involvement within the Cursillo movement. It is alive but we still need to put more effort into bringing awareness of Cursillo to our communities.

I felt challenged by the Spirit while listening to a Christian radio station. The speaker asked his audience to stop and reflect on what Christ asked His followers to do. What came to mind was our catechism teaching: to know, love and serve God. Many get to know God through regular mass attendance, maybe some bible study and talking to Him in prayer. What the speaker was concerned about was legalism, which he described as being solely focused on the laws and expectations of the church, or following the rules but not taking seriously Christ's command to expand His church. We sometimes forget this important part of His message. The speaker said, we may put too much focus on doing things instead of reaching out and inviting others to join us in our walk with Christ?

In Matthew 28:19-20, Christ said "19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

We, as Cursillistas, need to ask ourselves if we are keeping the good news to ourselves instead of offering it to others to help aid them in their continuous conversion process. As a sponsor you can develop a deep spiritual relationship with your candidate, which goes beyond friendship. Take some time now to reflect on what you can do to build Christ's church, asking the Lord for help in identifying people who could join you on your walk, and become a spiritual friend on the journey.

If you have a candidate and have not sent in an application yet, send **\$175.00 with the application** and the application will be confirmed. **The men's # 223 will be March 6-9, 2014.** We expect to fill Saint Margaret Mary Parish at the Cursillo Center, which is located at 6920 La Boiteaux Road, on the corner of La Boiteaux and Galbraith Roads in Cincinnati. The cost will be **\$175.00 for the weekend which includes meals and accommodations.**

**Candidate confirmation:** If you have already submitted an application, **send a check for \$175.00 to confirm a spot** on the weekend. If you have a candidate and have not sent in an application yet, send **\$175.00 with the application** and the application will be confirmed. **The men's # 223 will be March 6-9, 2014.** We expect it fill up early so do not wait until the last minute to confirm. Once the check is received a confirmation letter will be sent to both the sponsor and the candidate.

If you have a candidate but they cannot make this particular weekend, send in the application but without the payment. We like to have all interested applicants send in an application prior to a weekend being announced so that we know the number interested before a date is set. **Do not send a check with the application unless a date is set and your candidate wishes to attend that particular weekend.**
